Features

Bodywork is constructed to the highest standards using one piece "stress" panels enclosed within an extruded aluminium "space frame".

Double glazing throughout and with integral insulation (U factor 0.9).

Interiors are fitted out with quality cabinetry to suit our customers specific requirements, centralised drawer locking and door push locks come as standard. Laminates, flooring, upholstery, blinds and walls chosen from our complementary colour ranges.

Options

Welfare step lift, hide-a-way wheel chair lift or steps with handrail provide easy access. The option of our sliding "plug" door improves practicality in the entrance/exit area.

Hydraulic levelling legs powered by a vehicles power take off are now generally fitted to motorised units whilst trailers normally have stabilising jacks or side winder legs.

Completely independent mobile health units can be built incorporating a heating system and generator that runs off the vehicle's engine fuel. Enough electric to power all the equipment, air conditioning if required, extractor fan, heating and lighting can be provided by such a generator. Alternatively, depending on the use of the unit, 12 or 24 volt lighting systems can be supplied to supplement mains "plug in" electric when unavailable.

Bottled gas may be used as fuel to provide water/space heating and cooking facilities if required.

Plumbing options include a mains pressure water system or hose filled (polypropylene) tank with automatic pump and waste tank.
